

BARNES BOWLING CLUB SOCIAL DISTANCING POLICY

Guidance is based on Government Guidelines.

USING THE GREEN

The Green is for the use of Members Only - No Guests permitted to play. Hourly slots can be booked from 11am to 4pm Monday to Friday and 11am to 1pm Saturday and Sunday. Those who book slots may invite two member guests to watch their play if they wish. The member guests must leave the club with the players at the end of the hourly slot.

From 5-11pm Monday to Friday and 2-11pm Saturday and Sunday it is turn up and play with a maximum of 20 people in the club at any one time socially distancing.

Competition matches can be booked online at any time from 11am-10pm for the normal one-hour slot and will take priority over other members. After you have finished your match of 11 points, please leave the green for others to be able to play. Please take away your own litter.

GROUPS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING

From Monday 14th September, Government restrictions state it is now illegal for people in England to meet in groups of more than six, indoors and outdoors. Anyone found flouting the rules could be fined – please restrict any groups to no more than six and do not crowd the bowling platforms when play is in progress.

PLAYING RULES

Club woods and jacks are to be wiped with sanitizer before and after each match. If you want to bring your own jack please do. Do not touch any club woods or jacks other than the ones you are playing with. Please bring your own towels for wiping the woods you are using whilst playing if you need to and take the towel away with you, or if you have a locker store the towel in your locker for your own use only.

When using club woods please use the paper towel and sanitizer provided to clean the woods prior to returning them to the woods holder. To avoid cross contamination please do not use chalk and blackboards. Keep your own scores.

FACILITIES

Both doors to the clubhouse will be open. The rear door for access to the kitchen for the washing of hands and the front door for those collecting, cleaning and replacing their woods. Both doors will operate a one in and one out system. Please ensure only two people are in the clubhouse at any one time, one at the locker end one in the kitchen washing hands.

The use of the kitchen will be for washing hands only. The fridge and the contents of the cupboards will not be in use. The club will provide sanitizer spray for cleaning the woods and jacks and soap and paper towels for the washing of hands. Please use and dispose of the paper towels in the bins provided.

HEALTH

Anyone using the club must observe any quarantine restrictions in force. Anyone displaying any Covid-19 symptoms should not attend the club. If after visiting the club you display symptoms please contact The Committee immediately so that contact and tracing measures can be put in place.

Please observe the social distancing measures and respect other people. Everyone has a responsibility to ensure the safety of each other and the club environment.

As and when Government Policy changes we will update Social Distancing Policy based on the then current advice.
